

## NUHW IS OUR UNION

Together, we've built a union that reflects who we are as healthcare professionals. In NUHW, we all have a voice, and we all have a vote.

We have a transparent union with elected stewards and organizers who respond to issues and support us when help is needed. Our recent victories include:

- Baseline standards for Registered Dietitians and Health Educators to ensure they have time for consults and classes as well as time to prepare for appointments and document appointments.
- 2. Guidelines for Audiologists to receive more time for certain patients, such as those with dementia, so they're not being rushed through appointments.
- Reclassification of several Speech Language Pathologists from per diem status so that they receive health benefits as well as an agreement with Kaiser to identify other members of our unit who should also be reclassified.
- 4. Protecting our scopes of practice and preventing our members from being thrown into the labor pool during the pandemic.

The contract we signed includes essentially the same wage increases as UNAC's, but with a much better performance bonus. Now isn't the time to toss aside our raises and go right back into bargaining with UNAC, especially at a time when UNAC members couldn't support us because they're already under contract.

In the last couple of months approximately 850 RNs and Professionals from Fountain Valley Regional Hospital have voted to leave UNAC and join our union. Just a few weeks ago, our fellow NUHW members who provide mental health care for Kaiser in Southern California voted
